## Nominations are being sought for the 2024 "Eddie Slayton Memorial Award"

In recognition of a life dedicated to serving others especially the children of Clarke, Washington and Choctaw counties, the Regional Child Advocacy Center, Inc. Board of Directors has established the "Eddie Slayton Memorial Award." The award is named for the late Eddie Slayton, a longtime member of the agency's Board of Directors and a dedicated advocate for children.

This annual award is given to an individual who has benefitted children in this three county region above and beyond their job duties or has been exemplary in their volunteer service for children. The award is bestowed upon the nominee at the organization's annual benefit, the "Honor Thy Children" Dinner and Auction which is being held March 2, 2024 at the H.G. Pearce Memorial Assembly House in Jackson, AL. Last year's winner was Elaine Philon Davenport of Chatom, AL was recognized for her exemplary work with the Washington County DHR Services Division and her dedicated volunteer work to improve the lives of children Washington County. The eligibility criteria are as follows; the individual demonstrates his/her commitment to children in an exemplary manner through their profession and/or volunteer work, the individual has significantly benefitted children in Clarke, Washington or Choctaw counties over the past few years, and the individual is not a current member of the Board of Directors or staff of the Regional Child Advocacy Center, Inc. The Board is currently seeking nominations for this special award.
